

Privacy Policy

Welcome to the website (the “Site”) of MB Compliance, LLC. This Privacy Policy describes how the Site treats your use of the Site, including the handling of personal information. For purposes of this Privacy Policy, this Site includes by definition, any web pages, interactive features, applications, widgets, blogs, social media, or other online or wireless offerings that post a link to this Privacy Policy, whether accessed via computer, mobile device or other technology, manner or means. We reserve the right to revise this Privacy Policy at any time. Your use of the Site after such changes constitutes your agreement to the new policies. 1. Information Collection.

When you visit our Site, we may collect information automatically to administer the Site and analyze its usage. Examples of information we may track include:

- Your IP address.
- Your Browser or kind of computer you use.
- Number of links you click within the site.
- State or country from which you accessed the site.
- Date and Time of your visit.
- Name of your Internet Service Provider.
- Web page you linked to our site from.
- Pages you viewed on the site.

2. Use of Cookies and Pixel Tags

We use standard technologies such as a “cookie” and pixel tags to collect information about how our Site is used. A cookie is a small removable data file that is stored by your web browser on your computer. We use cookies to, among other things, identify your computer during a particular visit to the Site and analyze the Site visitor behavior. If you create a user account or otherwise join our Site, these cookies enable you to store your password for fast logon or other conveniences. We do not store personal or sensitive information in cookies. Most web browsers provide you with the ability to accept or decline cookies, as well as to be warned each time a cookie is being sent. If you choose to decline cookies, however, you may not be able to take advantage of all aspects of the Site. Pixel tags, also known as beacons or clear GIF’s, help us better manage content on our site by informing us what content is effective. Pixel tags are tiny graphics with a unique identifier, similar in function to cookies, and are used to track the online movements of web users. In contrast to cookies, which are stored on a user’s computer hard drive, pixel tags are embedded invisibly on web pages.

The information we learn helps us to personalize and continually improve upon your experience at MB Compliance, LLC. When you register, or otherwise provide information to us voluntarily, we will request some personal information such as name, address, email, telephone number, account number and other relevant information. If you are purchasing a service, we will request financial information. Any financial information we collect is used only to bill you for the services you purchased. If you purchase by credit card this information may be forwarded to your credit card provider. For other types of registrations, we will ask for the relevant information. You may also be asked to disclose personal information to us so that we can provide assistance and information to you. For example, such data may be warranted in order to provide online technical support and troubleshooting. We receive and store any information you enter on our Site or give us in any other way. We use the information that you provide for such purposes as responding to your requests, improving our services, and communicating with you.

Email Communications: To help s make emails more useful and interesting, we often receive a confirmation when you open email from MB Compliance, LLC if your computer supports such. As a part of the tracking and managing service that MB Compliance, LLC provides, we may email updates to you on a regular basis.

3. Sharing Information

For the purpose of operating our business, we may transfer any information collected to service providers who use that information to conduct our business. For example, they may handle credit card processing, email distribution, market research, information analysis, and promotions management. We may also share your information to administer a Site feature. We provide our service providers with the information they need to perform their services. The information that you submit on the Site may be provided to those vendors so that those vendors can provide services on our behalf.

For example, we store the personal information you provide on computers systems with limited access and located in controlled facilities.
